- The pulp and paper industry is the world's fifth largest industrial consumer of energy. It also uses more water to produce one tonne of product than any other industry¹
- Producing one tonne of paper requires two to three times that weight in trees. Paper production uses millions of trees every year¹
- Paper production in Australia produces hundreds of thousands of tonnes of greenhouse gas emissions every year²
- Printing, copying, packing, posting, storing, filing, finding, disposing and recycling paper can cost businesses up to 31 times as much as the cost of the paper itself³
